RON ARTIS II & FRIENDS

Hailing from Haleiwa and the eldest of 11 siblings, Ron Artis II played five instruments as a child, following in the footsteps of his singer-songwriter parents. Long-motivated by building and providing for community more than by his own personal passion, this mindset was instilled in Artis by his late father, local artist Ron Artis the first. Their home on the North Shore of O'ahu became an oasis for neighbors, music-lovers, and any combination of such. Best known for The Ron Artis Family Band, Artis II has continued his father's legacy, going on to create music with his brother Thunderstorm, before working on other projects such as this.

Artis II is joined by John Oates, bringing decades worth of trailblazing music industry experience with him. Best known as one half of best-selling duo of all time, Oates has an extensive career in music including 7 solo albums and induction into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame.

Local artist Jenny Yim opens, in partnership with the Henry Kapono Foundation's On the Rise program.

ACCESSIBILITY

Please share any special seating needs you may have to the staff member assisting you with your ticket order. Wheelchair locations and infrared listening devices are available.

CHILDREN

All patrons require a ticket for paid events, including children. Out of consideration for the general audience, the Hawaii Theatre discourages bringing children four years of age or younger, except for programs specifically for young audiences. "Babes in arms" will not be admitted to the Theatre.

MASKS

The health and safety of audiences and employees is the Hawaii Theatre Center's highest priority. To minimize the risk of contracting the coronavirus, masks are strongly recommended while inside the Theatre.

PHOTOGRAPHS AND RECORDING

Cameras and recording devices may not be brought into the Theatre without the express consent of the Hawaii Theatre management.

PERSONAL ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT

Please silence all electronic devices, including watches, pagers, and phones.

FOOD AND BEVERAGES

No open food or beverages may be brought into the auditorium. In an effort to maintain the quality and atmosphere of the historic Hawaii Theatre, beverages consumed in the auditorium must be in enclosed containers.

Reusable keepsake tumblers may be purchased to bring beverages inside the auditorium. There are two concession stands available on the second floor lobby before the show and during intermissions. A selection of snacks & beverages are available for purchase and may be eaten in the lobby areas outside of the auditorium. Hawaii law prohibits the sale of alcoholic beverages to minors.

RESTROOMS

Public restrooms are located on the first and second levels of the theatre.

SMOKING

Fire regulations strictly prohibit smoking anywhere inside the Theatre. Smoking is prohibited within 20 feet of the Theatre entrance.

LATECOMERS

Latecomers will be seated at the discretion of the house manager during appropriate pauses in the program.

FOR YOUR SAFETY - DURING THE SHOW

When possible, please remain in your seat until the house lights are on.

TAXI SERVICE

For your convenience, the house manager or an usher will be happy to arrange for taxi service from the Theatre.




